**Concrete Coatings to Meet Performance and VOC Demands**

Steven R. Thompson, Lubrizol Advanced Materials

Concrete is the fastest growing construction material in the world. Customer expectations for concrete durability and appearance have increased with its use. Conventional, high VOC coatings can provide protection from weathering and man-made destructive forces such as tire and foot abrasion. The challenge is to achieve this level of performance for exterior surfaces and at low VOC. Two approaches have been studied. (1) the use of solution acrylic in exempt solvents and (2) a waterborne acrylic emulsion with optimum hardness to provide excellent hardness, good adhesion and excellent water sensitivity (resistance to blushing/whitening) when immersed in water after a very short dry time. These approaches produce products for overlapping as well as distinctively different concrete coating requirements.
